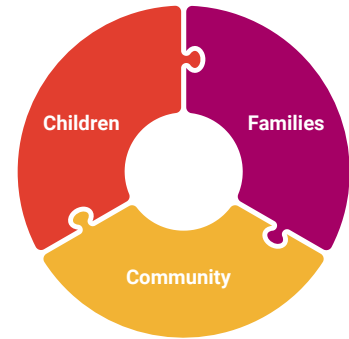




2030 Impact Agenda

IMPACT GOALS



Opportunities for all Children: Support a healthy start and quality learning experiences for all children, regardless of race, income, neighborhood, or ability.

- More children are born healthy and expectant mothers are healthy before, during, and after childbirth.
- More children and adults will be fully insured and able to access quality healthcare services.
- Increase access to high-quality, affordable early childhood education and resources for caregivers.
- More children will succeed academically, advance to higher grades, and graduate high school.
- Improve access to fresh, healthy food for children and their caregivers.



Economic Mobility for Families: Invest in efforts to help working families obtain stable, high-quality jobs and take control of their financial future.

- Improve job skills among unemployed/underemployed adults and make quality job connections.
- Reduce barriers to work, including transportation, quality, affordable childcare, and accommodations.
- By providing access to affordable housing and financial tools, empower families to increase savings.
- Increase access to small business support to empower families to build stability and create jobs.
- More local workplaces provide access to family-friendly benefits like flexibility and childcare support.



A More Connected Community: Build a vibrant, engaged, and equitable community where children and families can thrive.

- Improve access to safe, inclusive outdoor environments to promote active family lifestyles.
- Improve mobilization and collaboration of community resources for disaster relief and recovery.
